
APCO Standing Committees & Commercial Members

Each committee and task force is very important to the overall structure of the APCO organization. Now is your opportunity to get involved and contribute your time and talents by volunteering for a committee or task force.



APCO International presents annual awards to public safety communications personnel recognizing those who have demonstrated the highest levels of performance in the practice of public safety communications. Nominees must have been employed in the applicable category by a public safety agency at any time between April 1, 2016 and March 31, 2017. Nominees do not have to be members of APCO.

Award recipients will receive a VIP trip to the 2017 APCO Annual Conference & Expo. The VIP treatment will include travel expenses, hotel accommodations and conference registration. During the conference, recipients will be recognized on stage in front of their peers from around the nation. They will also be featured in a press release and in an article in APCO's *Public Safety Communications* magazine announcing the winners.

Nominations for the **Technology Leadership Award** are also being accepted for both the Large Agency(76+ Employees) and Small Agency(1-75 Employees) categories. This award is intended to recognize an emergency communications center's use of technological advancement to increase operational efficiency and provide a higher level of service to the customers it serves. Nominations should detail the positive impact of the implemented technology as well as any modifications to policies and procedures. Examples of projects include but are not limited to computer aided dispatch (CAD), radio systems, 9-1-1 answering equipment, public safety IT, broadband, electronic crime reporting, mapping, GPS, etc. The Award Recipients for the Technology Leadership Award shall receive a complimentary "daypass" registration to APCO 2017 for the day of the award ceremony. A representative from the winning PSAP(s) will be recognized at the annual conference, in Public Safety Communications and on the Web site.
